APPLIED LESSONS: Private study of the same instrument or voice is required for four years, or those semesters declared as a Musical Theatre Major. There is an additional fee for these lessons. "Jury" will be expected each of these semesters.

PERFORMANCE ENSEMBLES: Participation in a large performing ensemble is required for four years or those semesters declared as a Music Major unless otherwise approved by the department. All Musical Theatre Majors are expected to attend college concerts and recitals.

SENIOR RECITAL: Musical Theatre Majors are required to perform a senior recital during the spring semester of their senior year.

PROFICIENCIES: Proficiencies may be filled with major, core, and/or elective courses.
